Carinthia at a Glance

Austria's southernmost state

- **Capital** Klagenfurt am Wörthersee
- **Population** approx. 568,000
- **Area** 9,536 km²
- **Location** Southern Austria, borders Italy & Slovenia
- **Languages** German, Slovenian minority
- **Landmarks** Lindworm, Großglockner, Lake Wörth
- **Known for** Lakes, mountains, cuisine, football

Turquoise lake & Maria Wörth



Carinthia's jewel

- Largest lake in Carinthia (19.4 km²)
- Drinking-water quality, up to 28 °C
- Maria Wörth: peninsula with Romanesque pilgrimage church (9th c.)
- Popular holiday & festival destination

Pyramidenkogel

Tallest wooden observation tower in the world



Panoramic view over Lake Wörth

- 100 m tall, opened in 2013
- Tallest wooden tower worldwide
- Three viewing platforms
- 120 m slide – Europe's highest
- Spectacular 360° view of Carinthia

Lindworm Fountain Klagenfurt

Landmark of the state capital



The dragon at Neuer Platz

- Erected in 1583 from chlorite schist
- Symbol & heraldic animal of the city
- Legend: dragon defeated at the marshy shore of Lake Wörth
- Popular meeting point downtown

Hochosterwitz Castle

One of Europe's most beautiful castles



172 m above on dolomite rock

- First mentioned in 860
- 14 gates along the castle path
- Owned by the Khevenhüller family
- Landmark of central Carinthia
- Museum, falconry, restaurant

Großglockner High Alpine Road

Austria's highest mountain (3,798 m)



Alpine panorama at its finest

- 48 km panoramic road
- Connects Carinthia with Salzburg
- Highest point: Hochtorn (2,504 m)
- View of the Pasterze glacier
- One of Austria's most-visited sights

Minimundus

The small world by Lake Wörth



165 buildings at 1:25 scale

- Miniature park in Klagenfurt
- Opened in 1958
- Famous buildings from around the world
- 26,000 m² park grounds
- Family highlight at Lake Wörth

Kölnbrein Dam

Austria's tallest dam



Airwalk in the Malta Valley

- 200 m tall arch dam
- At 1,902 m altitude
- Built 1971–1979 (VERBUND)
- Airwalk: viewing platform with glass floor over the abyss
- Toll Malta High Alpine Road

Eagle Arena Landskron Castle

Bird-of-prey park near Lake Ossiach



Flight show above the castle ruins

- Castle ruins from the 9th century
- Eagle Arena since 2005
- ~50 birds of prey: eagles, falcons, vultures, owls
- Daily flight shows Apr–Oct
- 360° panoramic view of Villach

Obir Dripstone Caves

Underground natural wonder



Bad Eisenkappel • UNESCO Geopark

- 800 m show-cave loop trail
- Constant 8 °C – dress warmly!
- Stalactites with light & sound installations
- Open to visitors since 1991
- Guided tour approx. 1.5 hours

Nocky Flitzer · Turracher Höhe

Alpine coaster at 2,000 m



Summer tobogganing with a view

- 1.6 km long alpine coaster
- Start: Panoramabahn mountain station
- Curves, spirals, jumps & waves
- Family highlight from age 3
- Operating year-round
- Three mountain lakes around the pass

Stadium Klagenfurt

- Location: Sportpark Klagenfurt
- Opened: 2007 (UEFA EURO 2008)
- Capacity: approx. 30,000 seats
- Architect: Albert Wimmer (Vienna)
- Home of Austria Klagenfurt
- Concerts & major events
